Also, clearly indicate on the transcript "honors" or "advanced placement" courses with test scores and any courses completed from a college or university curriculum for which high school credit is earned. Place page 3 of this application in this envelope for submission.

Provide one or more original letter(s) from a guidance counselor, teacher, mentor, employer, supervisor, or some other person that has been involved with your Architecture experiences.
